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Palm Beach, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health in Palm Beach County (DOH-Palm Beach) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels in the following location:

Palm Beach, FL 33480**

Tests completed on Monday, December 29, 2025, indicate that the water quality at Palm Beach shows an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines. Test results are available at FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches.
