




# Substance Use & Communicable Disease Surveillance: MRSA in PBC

In the recently published OD2A Non-Fatal Overdose Surveillance Report for 2021, a significant rise in MRSA cases has been detected. While some of this can be explained by improvements in data surveillance strategies, it is important to understand factors of transmission and continue surveillance for potential prevention recommendations.

### **OD2A Annual Report Results:**

- MRSA infections occurred more often among those with a substance use history, especially among those with history of intravenous drug use.
- There is no statistical significance between MRSA infections and type of substance used (opioid, stimulant, or benzodiazepine).
