




#### Now Available: OD2A's Fatal Overdose Surveillance 2021 Annual Report

The Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) program of the Florida Department of Health in Palm Beach County has completed its Fatal Overdose Surveillance Annual Report, Palm Beach County, 2021. The 2021 fatal overdose surveillance sample reviewed 577 cases obtained from the Palm Beach County Medical Examiner Office.

#### Key Findings:

- 2021 had the highest number of
  overdose deaths since 2017, with a 2.3%
  increase from 642 deaths in 2020 to 657
  in 2021.
- > For every 100,000 people, **44** died from an overdose in 2021.
- An average of **1.8** people died of an overdose each day in 2021.
