










Type of Substance(s) Reported in ED Overdose Visits





Monday had the most EMS events of any day of the week






The Rise of Novel Psychoactive Substances in Palm Beach County:

Fluorofentanyl

Palm Beach County OD2A has been monitoring the increase in deaths from fluorofentanyl, an emerging opioid analog.

What We Know:

- Fatal overdoses in PBC have increased 737.5% from 8 in 2021 to 67 in 2022 (YTD).
- A recent CDC MMWR report shows a similar trend, with fluorofentanyl deaths increased 455.3% from 2020-2021.
- Most overdose deaths from fluorofentanyl involved multiple substances, particularly illicitlymanufactured fentanyl (IMF).



CDC Recommends:

Expand naloxone access: timely administration saves lives. **Ensure treatment services** and expand prevention programs. **Enhance toxicology testing** to detect fluorofentanyl and other emerging psychoactive substances.
