REQUIREMENTS OF HAZARDOUS WASTE GENERATORS

It is a requirement of the amended Palm Beach County Ordinance 97-58, that every business generating <u>any amount</u> of hazardous waste is required to be licensed and pay an annual fee to the Palm Beach County Health Department (PBCHD). Furthermore, in order to obtain and maintain this required County permit, compliance with all Federal, State, and local laws and regulations must be maintained. Information regarding these laws and regulations may be found at www.dep.state.fl.us for State environmental regulations and www.epa.gov for Federal environmental regulations as well as contacting your local municipality for any local laws.

Examples of the businesses that are regulated by the PBCHD may include, but are not limited to:

Each HWG facility is subject to an unannounced, annual compliance inspection by the PBCHD. During a PBCHD inspection the following will be required by the inspector:

- Unrestricted access throughout the entire facility for inspection.
- Compliance with any additional requirements based on the facility's EPA generator status.
