The following list is intended for your use to ensure that all items have been addressed in order to receive approval to conduct a fire training exercise on any structures. In addition to normal permitting, an asbestos survey of representative materials must be done prior to commencement of the renovation, demolition, or burn to assure that materials having asbestos are either not present or have been properly removed and disposed. FDEP Notice of Demolition or Asbestos Renovation form submitted for burning any structure. This form certifies that no regulated asbestos is present or that all regulated asbestos including Category I and Category II non-friable asbestos-containing material will be removed prior to burn. This notification shall be submitted to the Florida Department of Health, PBC at least ten (10) working days before asbestos stripping or removal work or any other activity begins. Asbestos-containing materials may include, but are not limited to: - wall plaster or stucco - mastics (glues, adhesives) - insulation - ceiling treatment - vinyl floor tiles - ceiling tiles (popcorn ceiling) - wire insulation - pipe wraps - roofing materials - siding (cement panels) - fire doors - drywall and joint compounds - window glazing/caulking - linoleum flooring All hazardous materials that would endanger the health and safety of the firefighters, the public and the environment must be removed. Items that must be removed prior to the burn include, but are not limited to: - vinyl siding, flooring, products - batteries - draperies - mercury containing materials - linoleum - waste oil - asphalt shingles - appliances - clothing - furniture - electrical switches - carpet & foam - air conditioning equipment - plastic materials - smoke alarms - exposed PVC plumbing - exposed wiring - hazardous wastes - foam cushions, mattresses etc. - fiberglass materials (tubs, showers, etc.) - fluorescent lighting, ballasts and transformers - stored chemicals (pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, paints, glues, cleaners, tars, etc.)
